


Spruce is monoecious; male “flower” is a pollen cone (strobilus). On Norway spruce these are pink or pinkish white,

The female ‘flowering’ cone is upright and bright pink.



Sharp-pointed needles held singly on woody pegs; 1 inch long, medium green, mostly angled forward towards terminal bud. Terminal bud light tan and not resinous; outer scales often reflexed.

Norway Spruce (page 1 of 1)

‘Fruit is a woody cone with seeds located between the scales. The seed cone is pendulous, cylindrical and up to 5 inches long; greenish purple when immature, becoming brown at maturity.



Form is pyramidal with drooping secondary branches. Height: 40 to 60 feet
