



*Caulophyllum thalictroides*

Blue Cohosh (page 1 of 1)

The inflorescence is a panicle.



Flowers have 6 petal-like sepals which may be greenish or purplish; the petals are greatly reduced and much smaller than the sepals. Six short stamens sit on the petals and surround a single pistil.



Plant is unbranched; height 1 to 3 feet.



This plant has no true fruit. The blue berry-like structures are actually seeds with a blue seed coat.



Leaves are trifoliate (three sets of three leaflets). The end of each leaflet has 2 to 5 lobes.
