False rue anemone (page 1 of 1)

Flowers are solitary or in twos and threes.

The perfect flowers are white. Each flower has five petal-like sepals, but no true petals.

The fruits are beaked follicles (arrow).



The leaves are trifoliate and each leaflet is three-lobed. The middle leaflet has a longer petiolule than the two side leaflets.
