





The perfect, yellow flowers are solitary and may be 3 to 4 inches wide. Each flower has four large petals sitting atop a long calyx tube that contains a swollen ovary (arrow). The calyx falls away as the flower matures (lower right). The stigma is branched into a cross shape (left).



Fruits are capsules, 2 to 3 inches long and wide and have four wings.



The plant is fairly prostrate, only about 1 foot tall.



Alternate leaves, up to 5 inches long and lanceolate; margins entire or very broadly toothed.
