




*Halesia carolina*

The white, bell-shaped flowers are [perfect](#). Each flower has 4 [petals](#) and the flowers are in groups of 4 or 5. (Left: outside of flowers. Right: inside of flowers)




Fruit is a [drupe](#) with 4 wings. It will turn brown at maturity



Leaves simple and [alternate](#); [ovate](#) with finely [serrate](#) [margins](#); they are 3 to 6 inches long.



The [imbricate](#) buds have very few, loose scales. Stems are light brown, with a white, chambered [pith](#).

The mature form of the tree is open to rounded. Height: up to 35 feet.



Bark is platy when young, becoming a bit more furrowed with age.



Fall color is yellow. (Doggone it we don't have a picture yet.)
